Promoting and encouraging:

<u>Description of Competition: please note new divisions!</u>

<u>Jumping</u>: to follow a well-marked course at a safe (trot & canter) hunting pace as if hounds were running a line on the scent of a fox. Coops & natural obstacles; not to exceed 2'7". Most jumps will have a smaller alternative, approximately 2'. All coops and obstacles must be jumped in order & only after the third refusal may proceed around. Horse and rider must go between red and white flags (Red on right)

<u>Flat:</u> To follow non-jumping course, between red and white flags, with ways around jumps. May jump any obstacle, but does not need to jump all obstacles.

<u>Pleasure:</u> To follow much of the same course at a leisurely trail riding pace as if following the hunt before the hounds find the scent of a fox. Also known as "hill toppers". Please note: there will no longer be an "open division"

Rules:

- 1. All Entries will close at 10:00 am day of pace. Your cooperation is needed to get there before 10:00 am or to enter online before the day of the pace.
- 2. First horse on course 12:00 sharp. Jumpers are typically first out. Pleasure division goes last.
- 3. Entries received by midweek before the event or completed online will have first order of go and it may be possible to pick your approximate start time..
- 4. All divisions must be ridden by teams of 2 or 3. If you don't have a partner, come anyway and we'll pair you up with someone, or we'll arrange you to run as the third member of a team. Special permission may be given by organizer for a single rider wishing to ride alone for safety reasons.
- 5. Divisions must be declared when entering.
- 6 Courses will be open for inspection the day before the pace.
- 7. Course and fences will be well marked. If you are unable to walk the course before the pace, you may bring a map with you while you ride.

- 8. Fences must be jumped in numerical order, and may be excluded only after 3 refusals. Jumper division riders must declare any refusals to the finish line timer / judge.
- 9. All riders much pass check points and complete entire course. We will honor the honor system, so should you.
- 10. Teams may pass each other. Please make way for passing teams. Please be considerate and pass at safe speed, especially if you not ice the person in front of you having difficulty.
- 11. Last horse over Start and Finish line will be the team's time.
- 12. Informal dress: no tennis shoes or shoes without heels, <u>approved riding helmet</u> <u>must be worn while mounted for ALL riders. SEI Safety vests are encoraged.</u>
- 13. Please be considerate of landowner's properties.
- 14. In case of bad weather, the organizer reserves the right to cancel pace or alter the course prior to the pace for the safety of the riders.
- 15. Judges decision is final.
- 16. Course may be walked Saturday, all day and Sunday *before* the pace.
- 17. No jumping with any saddle with a horn.
- 18. No bareback.
- 19. Running martingale only. No standing martingales nor tie-downs permitted.
- 20. Any dangerous riding, reckless or cruel behavior as defined in USEF is strictly forbidden and will result in elimination.

Series awards will be part of EHSC Year End awards. Only EHSC members will be eligible, and must sign up for year-end awards any time during the show season before the first pace. This will also make you eligible for ALL Year End awards.

You must compete in same division and in at least 2 paces to be eligible. The whole team does not need to be signed up for Year End awards.

Winner of the Jumping Division will receive a year-end ribbon and the Sycamore Farms Challenge Trophy donated in the memory of Phil Cochran.

Winner of the Flat division will receive a year-end ribbon and the SUNNY trophy donated by Carla Werling.

Winner of the Pleasure Division will also receive a trophy and year-end ribbon. Rules for the Hunter Pace will be posted at the Secretary Stand.
