Division Descriptions:

Walk -Trot X-Rails - Open to riders with limited experience. Riders are not eligible for any other division. Canter in the Walk-Trot division may be penalized at the judge's discretion.

Walk-Trot-Canter X-Rails - Open to riders with limited experience. Riders are not eligible for any other division.

Beginner Rider Hunter – Open to riders of any age with limited experience.

Short Stirrup Hunter - Open to riders 12 and under with limited experience.

Long Stirrup Hunter - Open to riders over 12 with limited experience.

Novice Rider Hunter - Open to riders who have not won 5 blue ribbons.

Very Green Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their 1st calendar year of showing over fences.

Intermediate Rider Hunter - Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders.

Low Children's/Adult Hunter - Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders.

Low Hunter – Open to all horses and ponies and all riders.

Green Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd calendar year of showing over fences.

Children's/Adult Hunter - Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders.

All Junior riders (17 and under) mounted or driving AND all riders in over fence classes, or schooling over fences, must wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds current ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag.
