Class Descriptions

Walk-Trot and Canter Crossrails - Open to riders with limited experience.

Short Stirrup Hunter - Open to riders 12 years & under with limited experience.

Long Stirrup Hunter - Open to riders over 12 years with limited experience.

Very Green Hunter - Open to Horses and ponies in their first or second calendar year of showing over fences.

Hi / Low Hunter - Open to all horses.

Low Intermediate Hunter - Open to Juniors and Amateurs.

<u>Intermediate Rider Hunter</u> - Open to Juniors and Amateurs.

Low Children's Hunter - Open to Junior riders on Horses.

Children's Hunter - Open to Junior riders.

Adult Hunter - Open to Amateur riders 18 years and older. Novice Rider Hunter - Open to riders who have not won 5 blue ribbons.

Non-traditional equipment/ or attire may be penalized by the Judge.
