Open/Rider Sections:

Each of the six divisions are divided into two sections. The first section is called "open". This section is for horses and/or riders with experience at levels higher than the division being entered. Professionals may compete in these sections. The "rider" section is for less experienced riders on horses of any experience level. Professionals may not compete in the rider section.

Training Division: \$70

Dressage Test: 2014 Training Test A, Jumping 3'0 -3'3"

The Training Division is recommended for competitors who have successfully competed a year or more at the novice level. This is a standard USEA division. The cross country course may include banks, water, ditches and drops. Note: Cross country fences & stadium fences may be up to 5'3" wide at the base and up to 3'3" high. The stadium course will emulate a jumper course. Penalty points will be accrued for going too fast or too slow on cross country, & too slow in stadium. This division is for experienced eventers. (Max heights/widths will probably not be reached). XC optimum time: 420 mpm. Speed limit: 520 mpm.

Novice Division: \$65

Dressage Test: 2014 Novice Test A, Jumping 2'7 -2'11"

The Novice Division is recommended for horses and riders who are confident cantering and jumping obstacles. This is a standard USEA division. The cross country may include banks, water, ditches and drops. The stadium course will emulate a jumper course. Penalty points will be accrued for going too fast or too slow on cross country and too slow in stadium. XC stadium optimum times are 350 mpm, speed limit is 450 mpm.

Beginner Novice Division: \$65

Dressage Test 2014 Beginner Novice Test B, Jumping 2'0 -2'7"

The Beginner Novice division is recommended for competitors who are confident cantering & jumping obstacles. This is a standard USEA division. The cross country course may include up banks, water & ditches. The stadium course will emulate a basic jumper course. Penalty points will be accrued for going too fast or too slow on cross country, and too slow in stadium. Pony Club recommendation: C-1's, strong D-3's. XC optimum time: 325 mpm. Speed limit: 420 mpm.

Starter Division: \$60

Dressage Test 2014 Beginner Novice Test A, Jumping 1'6" - 2'0"

The Starter division is recommended for riders who are comfortable cantering & jumping small obstacles, and horses with some experience. The dressage test consists of walk, trot & canter and 20m circles. The cross country & stadium course consist of simple jumping efforts. Penalty points will be accrued for going too fast on cross-country. Stadium is not timed. Pony Club recommendation: D-3's, strong D-2's. XC optimum time: 280 mpm. Speed limit: 350 mpm.

Very Green Division: \$60

Dressage Test 2015 USDF Intro Test B, Jumping 1'6 - 2'0"

The Very Green division is recommended for lower level riders with basic jumping skills or inexperienced horses. The dressage test consists of walk, trot & 20m circles. The cross country and stadium course consist of straight forward jumping efforts (same course as Starter division). Penalty points will be accrued for going too fast on cross country. Stadium is not timed. Pony Club recommendation: D-2's. XC optimum time: 240 mpm. Speed limit: 325 mpm. Dressage reader is permitted.

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Intro Division: \$55

Dressage Test 2015 USDF Intro Test B, Jumping crossrails

The Intro division is recommended for lower level riders who would like an introduction to eventing or for inexperienced horses. The dressage test consists of walk, trot & 20m circles. The cross country course & stadium course may be completed at the walk, trot or combination of the two. Penalty points will be accrued for going too fast on cross country. Stadium is not timed. The stadium course will consist of small cross rails, verticals & brush boxes. Pony Club recommendation: D-2's, strong D-1's. XC optimum time: 200 mpm*. Speed limit: 325 mpm. Dressage reader is permitted.

*Optimum time (OT) for Starter, Very Green & Intro are for breaking ties only. No penalty points accrued for going too slow, just for going too fast.

EHSC Schooling Mini Trials

General Rules

Entire rulebook and updates can be found on mini trial website, www.minitrialassoc.org

Cross Country course will be open for schooling from 10am to 4 pm on Saturday August 26th before the event. SCHOOLING WILL STOP AT 4 PM PROMPTLY. NO EXCEPTIONS. Schooling may be available by appointment during the week by calling the organizer. Schooling will be weather permitting. It may be limited due to footing. All schooling must be paid in advance. Riders must check in with Secretary to verify release forms are signed, fees paid and to receive a number prior to entering the XC course. Numbers must be worn while schooling. All riders must be accompanied by an adult/ground person with a radio or cell phone.

NEW!! Show jumping schooling may be open on the Saturday before the event for schooling for \$10 round or \$25 for a 15 minute "fix a round." The fix a test round must sign up online www.minitrialassoc.org website in advance only. Post entries available only if space allows. Riders will have the choice of the following:

- Schooling jumping round(s) where the rider will jump the course.
- "Fix a Round" where riders will jump a schooling round then have additional time to work out the kinks with either your instructor or an instructor that we provide (for a total of 15 minutes) before jumping a second round.

Only the competitor may ride (warm-up) his/her horse on show day.

Late entries may be accepted after the closing date only if space is available. a \$25 late fee must accompany the entry form.

No refunds for entries accepted after the closing date. Refunds before the closing date may be accepted.

Negative Coggins test required for ALL out of state horses and must accompany entry.

This Mini Trial will be run under USEA/USEF rules where applicable. Attire will be informal. The event is a learning experience and the Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the rules. Divisions may be split or combined based on the information provided on the entries to accomplish this goal.

Schooling Dressage Tests will also be offered. A separate entry blank is available for these classes.
