Assisted Walk-Trot/Jog: This class is designed for riders not yet ready to show on their own. They are allowed 1 ground person in the ring to assist the rider in understanding the prompts from the judge. The ground person is only allowed to handle the horse in the event of a problem occurring in the ring (spook, etc.) and entering/exiting the ring.

Beginner Walk-Trot/jog: Open to riders 8 years of age and under. May not cross enter into WTC/WJL classes on the same horse/rider combination.

Novice Riders: Open to any rider 17 years or age and under. Riders may show walk-jog/trot or WTC/WJL but cannot cross enter between both on the same horse.

Open: Any rider 18 and over is eligible. Show management reserves the right to split into Pro and Non Pro divisions if entries warrant.

All Junior riders: (17 and under) mounted or driving **AND** all riders in over fence classes, or schooling over fences, must wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds current ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag.

Jackpot classes: All jackpot classes are open to all riders regardless of age. In mounted jackpot classes, the horse/rider combination must be able to canter/lope unless the jackpot class states otherwise. Professionals will be placed separately if entries warrant. **A minimum of 6 riders is needed to run each class.**

In-Hand Trail: Handlers in this class may cross enter in the Open and Walk -Trot divisions as long as they are eligible for that class but they cannot cross enter into both on the same horse. The trail class may run earlier depending on the number of entries. The pattern will be set up in ring 2 (middle arena).
